10 Key Qol Issues (2010)

- Ensure deployment separation does not determine child custody decisions
- No permanent custody orders
- Allow for expedited/electronic hearings for deployed parents
- Increase access to quality, affordable childcare for military families
- TX designated one of 13 pilot states
- Establish a DoD-funded child care liaison to work with state officials
- Promote enforcement of the predatory lending regulation
- anticipation loans DoD Regulation (32 CFR Part 232) places 36% APR limit on payday, vehicle title and refund
- Require authority for payday loans
- Unsuccessful in 2009 opposition from Credit Service Organizations
- Legislation sponsored by Rep Farias
- Discussed with Leslie L. Pettijohn, Commissioner, as a possibility

10 Key Qol Issues (2010)

- Improve absentee voting for military members and their families
- Email/On-line transmission of voting materials (MOVE Act)
- Expand use of the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot
- Provide emergency authority to the Chief Election Official
- Late registration procedures
- Enfranchise Citizens Who Have Never Resided in the U.S.
- Comport state laws with DoD rules on disposition
- Section 564 of Public Law 109-163, effective January 2006, requires active duty SMs to designate a person authorized to direct disposition of human remains (PADD)....occurs on DD Form 93 (Record of Emergency Data)
- Requires DD Form 93 be recognized in TX Stat. § 711.002
