

AT&T serves very rural areas in Texas

Examples of five high-cost-to-serve AT&T exchanges

Exchange	Exchange Square Miles	House- holds	HH Density
Catarina	195	61	1 HH per 3.19 square miles
Marathon	216	167	1 HH per 1.29 square miles
Allison	283	209	1 HH per 1.35 square miles
Cambellton	105	143	1 HH per 1.36 square miles
Midkiff	428	118	1 HH per 3.66 square miles



AT&T's high-cost funding from the TUSF is a fraction of what it was earlier – and is going to zero

- Since 2001, AT&T has reduced its annual high-cost TUSF support by \$160M, or **85%**

- By 2016, AT&T will have reduced its support **100%** under the new four – year settlement reached this year.
