The current map that is being considered by the Senate does not allow neither SD 31 nor SD 28 to be represented as well as they could be with a map that allows the districts to be set in a more north south orientation. If these districts were not strung out almost 8 hours from their most northern portion to the most southern portion but instead were more geographically compact, it would better serve the constituency of both districts. It would allow their Senators to be more accessible to a greater portion of their constituency on a more regular basis.

It would allow farming and agriculture communities to be better represented with a Senator who is not torn between focusing on the energy sector in the southern part of the district. Of course the reverse is true for the southern portion of those current districts in regard to being able to have their Senator focus primarily on energy vs being torn by the agriculture industry in the more northern parts of their district.

The problems that arise for both of these industries are often vastly different and thus need a Senator who can focus on those needs for their primary industry in their district. The map we have submitted will help address many of those issues and it simply makes more sense. It will allow communities who have these similar interests and industries to be in the same SD. A vote for the north south oriented Sd 31 and SD 28 will have benefits far reaching those I have mentioned here in this comment.
